



Lately I've been selling cardboard draw**R**ings that people seem to like, so I'll give you a tutorial on how I do it!

Tools



1. Outline your character

This can be done with marker or pencil—I usually use marker (though mark a small spot to see if these pages bleed). I also like to do multiple, usually complementary^A outlines for a lil spice and to get a richer black.



2. Color in big chunks

Quickly fill in big chunks of base color. I usually start with marker, then use pencil, but depending on the color I'm going for this can change (usually skin tones).

chunks can include shading!



3. Go. cray cray. with. COLOR!

This part is a little difficult to explain, but... get bright colors for some pop! A good rule of thumb is to keep cool colors with cool and warm with warm. I like to add neon reds, limes, teals, and oranges especially.

MAGIC EYE




