

GROCHET







"Soft Sounds from Another Planet" by Japanese Breakfast A review by Danya Evans



Soft Sounds from Another Planet is a dreamy escape. "Diving Woman" is the opening track with dreamy, ambient synths and an otherworldly guitar melody as the focal point. Japanese Breakfast fuses a multitude of genres from soft country melodies on "Boyish", to a punchy synth-heavy "Machinist". Many of the songs on this album are guitar and synth dense, however, brass instruments make a very quintessential appearance on the track "Till' Death", complimenting lead singer, Michelle Zauner's, voice perfectly. Her voice is the most beautifully performed instrument on this album. She has a stable and raw voice with a delicate cadence. Zauner uses it masterfully in the song "Jimmy Fallon Big!" whispering to create space and singing with her full strength to close it. Themes of love and grief are very apparent in the lyrics of this album. The words that stuck out ot me the most are "It was easy to leave, once you'd finally seen me" on the track "12 Steps". Soft Sounds from Another Planet is the perfect melancholy listen for the fall-winter. Japanese Denim creates an ethereal and intimate listening experience with hazy and transcendental sounds, accurate to its title, from another planet.




Sundays






